DECLARING FAILURE OF REQUEST FOR QUOTATION AND RECOMMENDING NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC EQUIPMENT FOR THE BSHM OF MINSU BONGABONG CAMPUS

WHEREAS, the Mindoro State University (MinSU), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) has advertised in the PhilGEPS and MinSU Website the Request for Quotation (RFQ) for the project "Supply and Delivery of Technical and Scientific Equipment for the BSHM of MinSU Bongabong Campus" with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000.00);

WHEREAS, in response to the first publication of the project on May 21,2024; four (4) suppliers were found in the document request list however, no supplier submitted Request for Quotation (RFQ) thus, declared failure of RFQ;
