WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, eight (8) suppliers were found in the document request list; however, two (2) suppliers in the name of **DUPLICAT NON-SPECIALIZED WHOLESALE TRADING** and **PAPERCAT OFFICE SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT TRADING** submitted price quotation before the deadline;

WHEREAS, **DUPLICAT NON-SPECIALIZED WHOLESALE TRADING** submitted price quotation for Lots 1, 2 and 4 while **PAPERCAT OFFICE SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT TRADING** submitted price quotation for Lots 1,2,3 and 4;

WHEREAS, the detailed evaluation of price quotation resulted in the following:

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by the suppliers, it was found out that the price quotation submitted by **DUPLICAT NON-SPECIALIZED WHOLESALE TRADING** for Lots 2 and 4 exceeded the ABC amount which was resulted into the disqualification of their quotation for the said Lots;

WHEREAS, the price quotation submitted by **PAPERCAT OFFICE SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT TRADING** for Lots 1, 2 and 4 also exceeded the ABC amount which was resulted into the disqualification of their quotation for the said Lots;



WHEREAS, despite having low price offer in Lot 3, the price quotation submitted by **PAPERCAT OFFICE SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT TRADING** was found to be unresponsive and uncompliant because of the following reason:
