WHEREAS, the bid proposal submitted by the abovementioned bidders passed the preliminary evaluation and were found to be substantially complying;

DECLARING FAILURE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER TWO-FAILED BIDDINGS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT FORM (ABC) AND SECOND PUBLICATION OF THE INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATION FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE PhilGEPS , MINSU WEBSITES, AND OTHER CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN THE UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS, Mindoro State University (MinSU), through Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) has advertised in the PhilGEPS and MinSU Website the project "Procurement of Motor Vehicles" with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php5,500,000.00) with two (2) lots specifically;

WHEREAS, the project was posted as Public bidding for the first time and then scheduled for an Opening of Bids on April 08,2024 hence, no submitted bids received. In addition, on its second publication it was scheduled for an Opening of bids on May 14,2024 however, still no bids were received.

WHEREAS, the former BAC decided to adjust and revise the Technical specifications of the items to be procured and revised the approved Purchase Request as well as the specifications indicated in the previous ABC Form and declared a Negotiated Procurement for the project due to Two-Failed bidding. Then, the BAC and its Secretariat, three (3) suppliers were invited to negotiate with, however only two (2) suppliers in the name of MINA DE ORO MOTORS INCORPORATED and TOYOTA CALAPAN CITY INC. responded, purchased and submitted the bidding documents; MINA DE ORO MOTORS INCORPORATED submitted bidding documents for Lot 1 while TOYOTA CALAPAN CITY INC. submitted bidding documents for Lot 2;

WHEREAS, on September 16,2024, the previous composition of the BAC posted and advertised the project in the PhilGEPS, MinSU websites and other conspicuous place from September 16, 2024 to September 19,2024;

WHEREAS, the Opening of Bids was scheduled on September 20,2024, but due to procedural concerns and the transition of the BAC composition, the bidding process was not fully executed;

WHEREAS, a new composition of BAC was constituted on September 23,2024 through Office Order No. 56, s. 2024 by the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE);

WHEREAS, on October 01,2024 the turn-over of the procurement documents from the previous BAC to the newly constituted BAC was completed;

WHEREAS, upon review of the ongoing bidding process for the Procurement fo Motor Vehicles, the newly constituted BAC discovered that the ABC Form amounting to Five Million Five Hundred Pesos (Php5,500,000.00) was not signed by the HoPE as required in the procurement process;

WHEREAS, the unsigned ABC Form constitues material defect in the bidding process rendering the procurement preceedings non-compliant with the established rules and procedures under RA 9184 and its IRR;





WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 41 Section 41 (b) of the 2016 Revised IRR of the RA 9184 to wit;

"The HoPE reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract in the following situations:
b) If the BAC is found to have failed in following the prescribed bidding procedures;

WHEREAS, the BAC hereby recommends approval of the ABC Form;

WHEREAS, the BAC hereby recommends the declaration of Failure of Negotiated Procurement – Two Failed Bidding for the "**Procurement of Motor Vehicles**" due to the unsigned Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) which constitutes irregularity in the bidding process;

WHEREAS, the BAC recommends the second publication of the Invitation for Negotiated Procurement – Two Failed Bidding for the Procurement of Motor Vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), above premises considered, hereby **RESOLVE** to recommend the Head of Procuring Entity;

2. to exercise her right to declare failure of Negotiated Procurement-Two Failed Bidding under Section 41 (b) of the 2016 Revised IRR of the RA 9184 and;

3. to approved the second publication of the Invitation for Negotiated Procurement – Two Failed Bidding for the Procurement of Motor Vehicles;



IV. THE FORM FOR PROXIES OF STOCKHOLDERS AND THE MANNER OF VOTING THEM

a) Stockholders may vote in person or by proxy in all meetings of stockholders. Proxies shall be in writing, signed by the stockholder and filed before the scheduled meeting with the corporate secretary. Unless otherwise provided in the proxy, it shall be valid only for the meeting for which it is intended. No proxy shall be valid and effective for a period longer than five (5) years at any one time.

V. THE QUALIFICATIONS, DUTIES, TERM AND COMPENSATION OF DIRECTORS

- a) No person convicted by final judgment of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of this Code, committed within five (5) years prior to the date of his election shall qualify as a director. Every director must own at least one (1) share of the capital stock of the corporation, which share shall stand in his name on the books of the corporation. Any director who ceases to be the owner of at least one (1) share of the capital stock of the corporation shall thereby cease to be a director. A majority of the directors must be residents of the Philippines.
- b) The corporate powers of the corporation shall be exercised, all business conducted and all property of the corporation be controlled and held by the board of directors to be elected from among the holders of stocks, who shall hold office for one (1) year and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- c) The directors shall not receive any compensation, as such directors, except for reasonable per diems. Any compensation may be granted to directors by the vote of the stockholders representing at least a majority of the outstanding capital stock at a regular or special stockholders' meeting. In no case shall the total yearly compensation of directors, as such directors, exceed ten (10%) percent of the net income before income tax of the corporation during the preceding year.

a) Matters not covered by the provisions of these by-laws shall be governed by the provisions of the Corporation Code of the Philippines.
