#### Instructions

### B. Technical Description

#### Introduction

In the field of mathematics education, a prevailing issue lies in the traditional learning process that often dissociates curriculum content from real-life contexts, hindering students' ability to relate mathematical concepts to their daily lives. To enhance the effectiveness of mathematics education, a shift towards contextualized learning, specifically localized and indigenized, is imperative. This necessitates the integration of cultural aspects into the teaching of mathematics, with a particular focus on ethnomathematics.

Ethnomathematics, as a research field, delves into the cultural dimensions of mathematics, aiming to present mathematical concepts in a manner that resonates with students' cultural and daily experiences. This approach facilitates the establishment of meaningful connections and deepens students' comprehension of mathematical concepts (Zhang & Zhang, 2010). Furthermore, ethnomathematics challenges the conventional notion that mathematical knowledge is universal and abstract. Instead, it acknowledges that diverse cultures contribute unique perspectives to mathematical understanding. This recognition promotes inclusivity and cultural diversity in the learning environment, fostering a more enriched educational experience. Moreover, implementing an ethnomathematical perspective in the school curriculum holds substantial benefits. Leveraging students' unique cultural referents fosters intellectual, social, emotional, and political learning, enhancing their knowledge, skills, and attitudes (Zhang & Zhang, 2010). Furthermore, ethnomathematics nurtures a sense of cultural pride and identity among students. When individuals see their cultural practices reflected in the mathematical concepts they learn, it not only makes the subject more relatable but also instills a sense of ownership and appreciation for their heritage. This emotional connection can significantly contribute to a positive and empowering learning environment.

Mathematical and cultural integration means contextual and realistic mathematics. Various researches on ethnomathematics have shown that mathematical ideas and practices, such as geometric principles and number sense, are born from handicraft activities, architectural concepts, and artifacts from many native, and local languages such as traditional stone throwing games called the Mozkat game in Israel (Fouze & Amit, 2018); then, mathematics in the creation of patterns in Canada (Ezeife, 2011); mathematics in traditional games in Nigeria (Yusuf et al., 2010); the Indian calendar system that has mathematics knowledge similar to the Maya tribe (Sirate, 2011); African mathematics that facilitates mathematics concepts (Horsthemke & Schafer, 2007); the relationship of art and





geometry symmetry in Africa (Marchis, 2009); and Mathematics in the craft of muzambi baskets in South Africa (Gerdes & Mozambique, 2011). These examples highlight the richness of cultural diversity in shaping mathematical thinking.

The Mangyans, a diverse ethno-linguistic group residing in Mindoro, engage in various crafts such as woven textiles, rattan and nito baskets, and beaded accessories, each reflective of their way of life and traditions. Despite the richness of cultural diversity among the Mangyan communities, there is a limited number of studies, especially in the exploration of Mangyan ethnomathematics.

To address this research gap, this study proposes an investigation into the ethnomathematics of the Mangyan community, aiming to shed light on the intricate connections between their cultural practices and mathematical concepts. Through understanding the unique ways in which mathematical thinking is embedded in their crafts, this research seeks not only to contribute to the broader field of ethnomathematics but also to provide valuable insights for the development of culturally responsive mathematics education.

## Project Objectives

### Study 1: Indigenous Mathematics in Action: Ethnomathematics Practices of the Hanunuo Mangyan

This study delves into the traditional ways the Hanunuo Mangyan people utilize mathematics in their everyday lives. It explores how they perform calculations for tasks like weaving textiles, constructing dwellings, and managing agricultural practices. This study aims to document their unique system of measurement, counting methods, and problem-solving approaches, revealing the rich mathematical knowledge embedded within their cultural practices.

### Study 2: Geometric Transformation and Patterns in the Handicrafts of the Hanunuo Mangyans

This study focuses on the geometric concepts and transformations woven into the beautiful handicrafts of the Hanunuo Mangyans. It analyzes the designs and patterns found in their baskets, textiles, and other creations, revealing the underlying mathematical principles. The study will explore concepts like symmetry, tessellations, rotations, and reflections, demonstrating how these indigenous artisans integrate mathematical knowledge into their artistic expressions.

## Methodology

### Study 1

To delve into the mathematical world of the Hanunuo Mangyan, a qualitative approach with ethnographic methods will be employed. In-depth interviews with elders, artisans, and community members will be conducted to understand their traditional practices. These interviews will be open-ended, allowing participants to share their experiences and knowledge about using mathematics in daily activities like weaving, construction, and agriculture. Additionally, participant observation will be a key component. Researchers will immerse themselves in these activities, observing how the Hanunuo Mangyans perform calculations, utilize measurement systems, and solve problems in their daily lives. Finally, collecting artifacts and tools used in these activities will provide further insight into their unique mathematical practices. The data collected from interviews, observations, and artifacts will be analyzed thematically to identify recurring concepts and practices related to how the Hanunuo Mangyans utilize mathematics in their world.

### Study 2

This study will take a combined approach, utilizing both quantitative and qualitative methods to understand the geometric concepts embedded within Hanunuo Mangyan handicrafts. Representative samples of their beautiful baskets, textiles, and other creations





will be collected. Interviews with artisans will be conducted to gain a deeper understanding of the design process and the cultural meaning behind the intricate patterns. Next, the quantitative aspect comes into play. Geometric software (Tinkercad, ImageJ) will be used to meticulously measure and analyze these patterns. This analysis will identify the underlying geometric principles such as shapes, symmetries, rotations, and reflections that are present in their creations. The final step will involve comparing the identified geometric principles with relevant cultural narratives and symbolism, if applicable. This will help bridge the gap between the mathematical and cultural aspects of their handicrafts.
