

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Introduction

Mindoro State University (MinSU) has continuously strived for excellence in education, research, and community engagement, shaping generations of learners and leaders. Its journey began with the establishment of the Mindoro Agricultural School (MINAS) through Republic Act No. 506, signed into law on June 17, 1950. 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
