PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Introduction

Mother's and Father's Day is a special occasion that recognizes the unconditional love, sacrifices, and contributions of parents. It is a time to express gratitude for their unwavering support, hard work, and dedication in nurturing their children and shaping their futures. This celebration aims to honor and appreciate the mothers and fathers of the MinSU community through a simple yet meaningful activity that promotes inclusivity, well-being, and gender sensitivity in line with the university's GAD initiatives.

Rationale/Significance

This Mother's and Father's Day celebration is a mandated Gender and Development (GAD) activity, anchored in the Mindoro State University's GAD Plan and Budget 2025 and in accordance with the directives of the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW). It forms part of the university's institutional commitment to promote gender-responsive programs that honor and recognize the diverse roles of parents in both domestic and professional spheres.

The activity provides a meaningful platform to express gratitude to mothers and fathers within the MinSU community, especially those who juggle responsibilities at work and at home. It also promotes work-life balance, emotional well-being, and inclusivity by highlighting shared parenting roles—aligning with Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 5: Gender Equality) and (SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being).

The selection of umbrellas for mothers and sun hats for fathers as tokens is grounded not just in appreciation, but also in practical health protection. With the Philippines currently experiencing intensifying heat waves and rising heat indices, aging individuals—particularly those in the workforce—are more vulnerable to heat-related illnesses. According to the Department of Health (DOH, 2024) and the World Health Organization (WHO, 2023), older adults face heightened risks of heatstroke, dehydration, and elevated blood pressure due to impaired thermoregulation and prolonged heat exposure.

This is particularly concerning for aging mothers, who are prone to post-menopausal hypertension, and fathers, who statistically experience cardiovascular strain in high-temperature conditions. Studies confirm that extreme heat can exacerbate pre-existing conditions such as high blood pressure, heart disease, and chronic fatigue—especially among individuals aged 50 and above (Mayo Clinic, 2022).

Moreover, current climate conditions have contributed to a rise in heat-induced metabolic disorders, renal stress, and respiratory concerns for both males and females. The provision of

weather-adaptive tokens not only symbolize care and recognition, but also supports preventive health practices, climate resilience, and the overall well-being of the university's faculty and staff. In integrating these elements into a gender- and age-sensitive program, MinSU affirms its commitment to institutional values of equality, health, and holistic care, as well as its compliance with GAD-mandated initiatives prescribed by the PCW and national GAD mechanisms.

Objectives

General:

To celebrate and honor the contributions of mothers and fathers within the MinSU community through a gender-responsive and health-conscious activity that fosters appreciation, inclusivity, and overall well-being.

Specific:

1. To recognize the vital role of mothers and fathers in both family and professional settings through a university-wide tribute aligned with the GAD Plan and Budget 2025.
2. To promote awareness of age- and gender-related health concerns, especially those intensified by extreme heat, by providing climate-adaptive and practical tokens.
3. To strengthen camaraderie, emotional well-being, and work-life balance among employees through inclusive and engaging activities.

Methodology

Conduct of Health Orientation and Awareness Program. The WGAD Unit, in collaboration with the University Clinic and HRMO, will lead the planning and execution of the event. The focus will be on health issues related to heat and other common health concerns, especially for aging males and females. Medical personnel will provide a simple talk on how heat and other factors impact health, along with practical tips for managing these concerns.

Audio-Visual Presentations, Tributes, and Awarding & Recognition. The program will include inspirational messages, video presentations, personal stories shared by selected students, tokens of appreciation, and a short tribute program. The event will take place in the university auditorium or gymnasium. (see attached Annex A. Program of Activities).

Education, Trivia-Quiz Bee. To encourage active participation of students and employees during the activities, an educational competition will be conducted through trivia-quiz via online event (Quizizz or other digital platforms). Trivia can be a fun and engaging activity for all ages, whether for entertainment or education. The trivia-quiz will focus on the general knowledge about history, importance, and relevant information on Father's and Mother's Day celebration.

Expected Outputs & Outcomes




