Brief History

The Mindoro State University (MinSU), formerly the Mindoro State College of Agriculture and Technology (MinSCAT), has grown from its humble beginnings as the Mindoro National Agricultural School (MINAS), created under Republic Act 506 authored by Congressman Raul T. Leuterio. It opened on August 26, 1951 with only 26 pioneering students. In 1963, Republic Act 3758 authorized the opening of its Collegiate Department, which paved the way for agricultural degree programs and later the institution's elevation into the Mindoro College of Agriculture and Technology (MCAT) in 1976. On May 25, 1995, MCAT became MinSCAT through R.A. 8007, making it the first state college in Oriental Mindoro.

A major milestone came in 2001 when MinSCAT expanded through the integration of two CHED-supervised institutions: the Bongabong College of Fisheries (established under R.A. 3306 in 1964) and the Polytechnic College of Calapan (established under R.A. 3397 in 1961).

These became the MinSU-Bongabong Campus, with its flagship programs in Fisheries and the MinSU-Calapan City Campus, with its flagship on Technology programs. Together with the MinSU Main Campus in Victoria, which remains strong in its flagship program in Agriculture and Allied Fields, the University established its tri-campus academic identity.

With its continued pursuit of academic excellence and institutional development, MinSCAT was converted into Mindoro State University on June 4, 2013 through R.A. 10596, later amended by R.A. 11006. On March 16, 2021, the Commission on Higher Education officially recognized MinSU as the full-fledged university, making it as a first university in the Mindoro Island.

As a state university, MinSU continues to advance its mission under the leadership of its first woman president, Dr. Enya Marie D. Apostol. With three strong campuses and distinct program thrusts, MinSU today stands as the premier higher education institution in Oriental Mindoro, envisioned to be a first-choice, premier, and globally competitive university for Mindoreños and beyond. Strengthened by strategic partnerships, research innovations, community engagement, and a strong commitment to sustainable development, MinSU is steadily gaining international recognition, reaffirming its dedication to excellence at par with global standards.
